[Playback devices] – dispozitive de redare audio

Sibelius folosește interfețele audio MIDI și ASIO instalate în computer. Fără a intra în detalii, acestea pot fi accesate de program, dar acesta trebuie să „știe” ce anume să facă cu ele. Toți parametri pot fi fixați prin intermediul ferestrei deschise de opțiunea [Playback devices]. După cum se vede această fereastră conține două tab-uri: Playback Devices (dispozitive de redare audio) și Input devices (Dispozitive de introducere a datelor, în cazul nostru tastatura MIDI) .

Playback and Input Devices

Playback Devices | **Input Device**

Click each playback device's Test button to see if you can hear it.

Set Use to Yes for one device and No for the others (unless you know you can use more than one at once). Also set Sound Set to the device name or type (e.g. General MIDI).

Playback and Input Devices

Playback Devices | Input Device

1. Highlight your input device, e.g. MIDI keyboard. (Typically this is the name of the port your keyboard is plugged in to.)

2. Try playing on your MIDI keyboard (or other input device): this indicator should light up.

3. MIDI Thru is for input devices which are silent (e.g. a master keyboard). It plays through one of your playback devices instead. Switch it off if your input device is not silent.

Click Find New Devices if one or more expected input devices is missing from the list above.
